

information on Akelius' processing of shareholder personal data

introduction

Akelius Residential Property AB (publ) ("Akelius") processes its shareholders' personal data.

This is why we are informing you as shareholder of our processing of your personal data, and your rights under data protection legislation.

Euroclear Sweden AB ("Euroclear") is responsible for keeping Akelius' share register. Euroclear is controller of processing of personal data that occurs in connection with this assignment.

which personal data do we process?

Shareholder personal data which Akelius processes is for example

- name,
- date of birth,
- social security number or other national identification number,
- address,
- telephone number,

- e-mail address,
- information on your shareholding such as number of shares,
- data from any communication between you and Akelius, including data in board meeting minutes and general meetings.

why and on which legal bases?

The personal data are used in connection with general meetings, for registration, drawing up of voting lists and, where applicable, minutes of the general meeting.

Akelius processes the personal data to fulfil our obligations under law, including corporation, securities and tax legislation and Akelius' legitimate interest in convening general meetings and administrating other company shareholder matters.

Akelius only processes your personal data for the purpose for which we collected the data. Should we need to process your personal data for any other purpose, or a purpose which requires your consent under data protection legislation, we will inform you and ask for your consent in advance.

transfer of personal data

Your personal data may be disclosed to other companies within the Akelius group or a third party if required by law, regulations or an official decision by a relevant authority.

Certain personal data, such as name and other information included in minutes of board meetings and general meetings, may be published on the company's website.

retention of personal data

We do not store your personal data longer than necessary for the purposes listed above or required by law.

Then we delete or anonymize your personal data so that it can no longer be connected to

you.

your rights as data subject

You have a number of rights as data subject, subject to applicable data protection legislation:

Right of access – the right of access to your personal data, meaning you are entitled to a confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you is being processed.

And where that is the case, access to the personal data and certain additional information on the processing.

Right to rectification – the right to rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning yourself, and to have incomplete personal data completed.

Right to erasure – the right to have your personal data erased if

- the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed
- you withdraw your consent to the processing and there is no other legal ground for the processing
- the processing of your personal data is not necessary for compliance with a legal obligation, for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims or archiving or scientific purposes

Right to object – the right to object and request a new assessment of legitimate interests when processing is based on these grounds.

We will then make a new assessment and will only continue processing, in spite of your objection, if we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds which override your interests.

Right to data portability – the right to data portability, meaning you are entitled to receive the personal data concerning yourself which you have provided us with, and to transmit those data to another controller.

Right to restriction – the right to restriction of your personal data, for example if you contest their accuracy or if you have objected to the processing as described above.

In both cases this right is applicable during our processing and verification of your request.

Right to lodge a complaint with the Swedish Data Protection Authority – if you think we are in breach of applicable data protection regulation in processing your personal data, <https://www.datainspektionen.se/other-lang/in-english/>.
